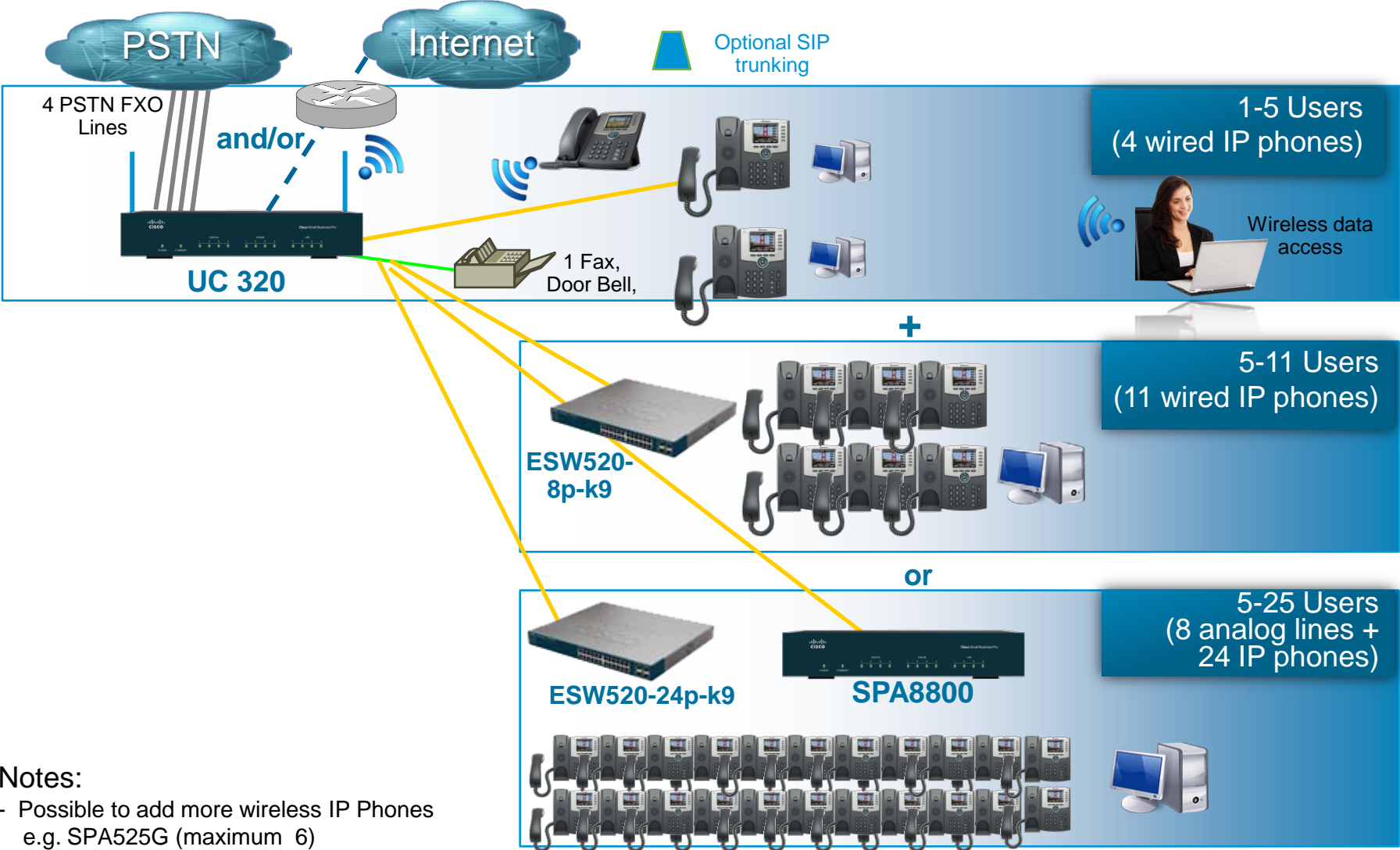

Session Initiation Protocol (SIP) Trunking

- Voice over IP (VoIP) service offered by Internet telephony service providers (ITSPs) that connects PBX to PTSN via the Internet
- Benefits:
 - Single connection delivers both voice and data to customers
 - SIP trunks dynamically allocate bandwidth based on usage
 - Offers significant cost savings by eliminating the need for local PSTN gateways, costly ISDN Basic Rate Interfaces (BRIs) or Primary Rate Interfaces (PRIs)
 - Cisco® Configuration Utility provides ease of installation for SIP trunking

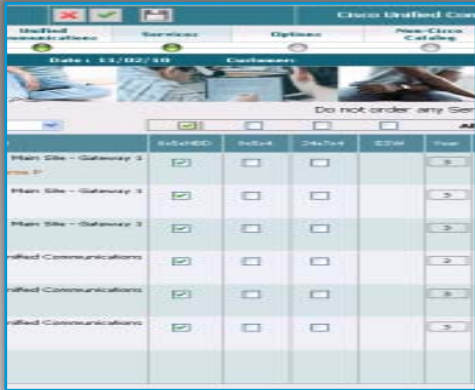

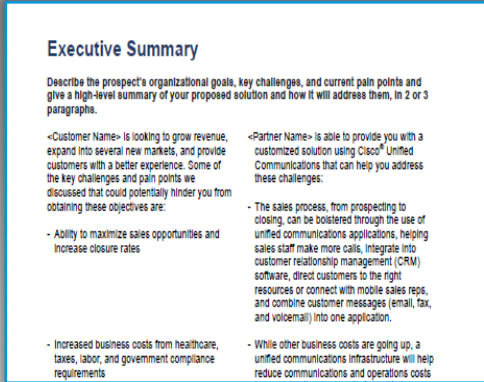
